- peppers (hot and sweet)
- root vegetables (carrots, beets, radishes, etc.)
- herbs (basil, parsley, rosemary)
- squash
- green beans
- garlic scapes & garlic
- chanterelle mushrooms
- herbal teas
- maple syrup
- jam, pickles
- sprouts
- eggs
- bread, pasta, and/or other baked goods made with our fresh ground wheat

We'll also include a recipe card each week to help you put your wonderful veggies to use! Other optional CSA items include plant starts, seeds, handmade soap, and angora rabbit wool.
